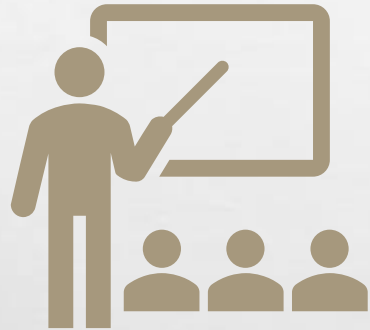

- PART TIME (ONE WEEKEND PER MONTH AND 2 WEEKS OF TRAINING IN THE SUMMER)
 - CAN BE CALLED TO FULL TIME TO SUPPORT COMBAT MISSIONS
- RESERVES – FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, NATIONAL GUARD – STATE & FEDERAL
 - MUST TAKE THE ASVAB

- **CREATE A LIST OF SCHOOLS WITH THE MAJOR YOU'RE INTERESTED IN.**
- **REQUEST INFORMATION ON SCHOOLS' WEBSITES.**
- **KNOW THE REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRANCE (GPA, TEST SCORES)**
- **WHAT'S IMPORTANT - COURSE OFFERINGS, CAMPUS LIFE, LOCATION, COST, SUPPORT SERVICES**
- **PLAN TO APPLY TO AT LEAST 6 SCHOOLS - 2 TARGET (MEET ALL REQUIREMENTS), 2 REACH (FIND A WAY TO STAND OUT), 2 SAFETY**
- **START COLLEGE TOURS - MANY SCHOOLS ARE OFFERING VIRTUAL TOURS, BE YOUR OWN TOUR GUIDE, SCHEDULE AN IN-PERSON TOUR WHEN OFFERED**

COLLEGE APPLICATIONS

- THE **COMMON APP** AND **SUNY APP** ARE THE MOST COMMON.
- OTHER APPLICATIONS: **COALITION**, **COMMON BLACK COLLEGE**, INDIVIDUAL SCHOOLS
- KNOW WHICH APPLICATION THE SCHOOLS ON YOUR LIST WILL ACCEPT.
- BE AWARE OF THE APPLICATION FEE FOR EACH SCHOOL YOU APPLY TO.
 - PRICES PER APPLICATION RANGE FROM FREE TO \$80. COSTS ADD UP FAST!

TYPES OF COLLEGE ADMISSIONS

- **EARLY DECISION**
 - **YOU APPLY EARLY AND IF YOU ARE ACCEPTED, YOU ARE OBLIGATED TO ATTEND THE SCHOOL AND MUST WITHDRAW ALL OTHER APPLICATIONS.**
 - **YOU, A PARENT, AND YOUR SCHOOL COUNSELOR MUST SIGN AN AGREEMENT THAT THE STIPULATIONS WERE DISCUSSED.**
- **EARLY ACTION**
 - **YOU APPLY EARLY AND CAN BE ACCEPTED EARLY WITH NO OBLIGATION TO ATTEND.**
 - **RESTRICTIVE EARLY ACTION – YOU CAN ONLY APPLY TO ONE PRIVATE SCHOOL UNDER THIS TYPE, BUT UNLIMITED PUBLIC SCHOOLS.**
- **REGULAR DECISION**
 - **YOU APPLY BY THE COLLEGE'S REGULAR DEADLINE.**
- **ROLLING ADMISSION**
 - **APPLICATIONS ARE REVIEWED ON AN ONGOING BASIS.**

EARLY DECISION VS. EARLY ACTION

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?

- **EARLY DECISION (ED): THIS IS A BINDING AGREEMENT WITH THE COLLEGE THAT IS YOU ARE ACCEPTED YOU WILL ATTEND**
- **YOU CAN ONLY APPLY TO ONE SCHOOL ED.**
- **IF ACCEPTED, YOU MUST WITHDRAW ALL OTHER APPLICATIONS**
- **YOU WON'T BE ABLE TO COMPARE FINANCIAL AID PACKAGES**
- **EARLY ACTION: YOU ARE ACCEPTED EARLY, BUT THERE IS NO OBLIGATION TO ATTEND**
- **CAN APPLY TO MORE THAN ONE SCHOOL UNDER EARLY ACTION**
 - **SOME PRIVATE SCHOOLS ARE RESTRICTIVE EARLY ACTION.**
- **WILL NEED TO DECIDE BY MAY 1ST- THIS GIVES TIME TO COMPARE FINANCIAL AID PACKAGES**

- **HIGHER EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM – PRIVATE SCHOOLS IN NY STATE**
- **YOU MUST QUALIFY ACADEMICALLY AND FINANCIALLY.**
- **YOU CAN'T APPLY TO A SCHOOL UNDER EOP/HEOP AND EARLY ACTION.**

SAT

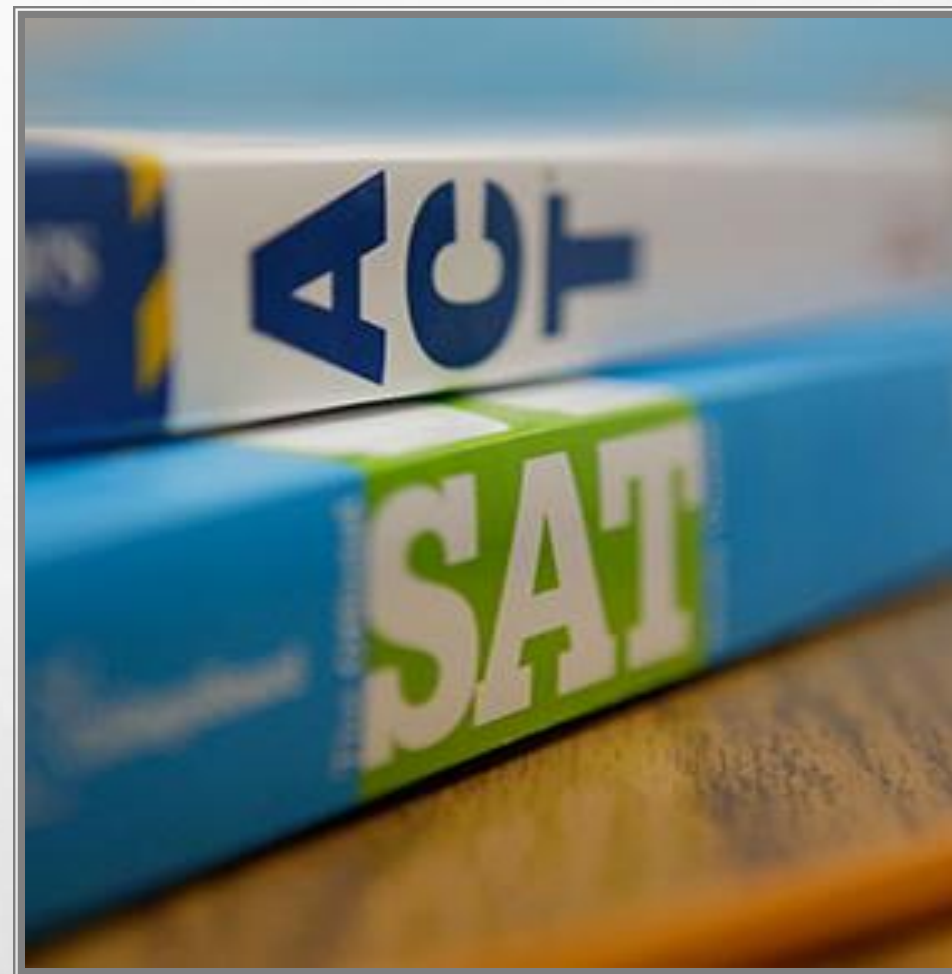
- Offered in March, May, June, August, October, November, & December
- 1600 points
- 4 sections, 2 areas: Critical Reading & Math
- College Board has discontinued the optional essay and SAT subject tests.

ACT

- Offered in April, June, September, & October
- Scored out of 36 points
- Tests English, Math, Science, and Social Studies

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON SAT/ACT

- **YOU CAN RETAKE THE SAT OR ACT.**
- **REPORTING SCORES TO SCHOOLS? COLLEGES WILL EITHER:**
 - **SUPERSCORE – TAKE THE HIGHEST SCORE ON EACH SECTION TO FORM A NEW TOTAL SCORE.**
 - **REQUIRE OR RECOMMEND ALL SCORES.**
 - **ACCEPT SCORE CHOICE – YOU DECIDE WHICH SCORES TO SUBMIT.**
- **SCORES CAN BE SENT TO FOUR COLLEGES FOR FREE.**
 - **ADDITIONAL COLLEGES CAN RECEIVE YOUR SCORES FOR \$12-15 PER SCHOOL. CHECK THE "FEES" PAGES ON THE COLLEGE BOARD AND ACT WEBSITES FOR MORE INFORMATION.**
- **IF YOU THINK YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR A FEE WAIVER, CONTACT YOUR SCHOOL COUNSELOR.**

TESTING POLICIES FOR COLLEGES

- **MANY SCHOOLS HAVE ANNOUNCED "TEST OPTIONAL" POLICIES DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC FOR THE FALL 2022 APPLICATION CYCLE.**
- **CHECK THE ADMISSIONS WEBSITES OF THE SCHOOLS YOU ARE INTERESTED IN FOR SPECIFIC DETAILS.**
- **THE DECISION TO REPORT YOUR SCORES IS UP TO YOU.**
- **SCHOOLS WILL BE LOOKING AT OTHER FACTORS (ESSAY, GRADES, LETTERS OR RECOMMENDATION, ETC)**



THE COLLEGE ESSAY

- **NEEDED FOR YOUR COLLEGE APPLICATION**
- **CAN OFTEN BE USED FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS**

SELECTING A TOPIC

Start early- decide on a topic over the summer.

Choose a topic that is important to you & had an impact on your life.

Make sure your essay is reflective - What have you learned, how has it changed you?

Essay writing is a process that takes time to develop – start early and write several drafts.

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION



- **WHO?**

- **A TEACHER WHO KNOWS YOU WELL & LIKES YOU!**

- **TAUGHT YOU RECENTLY**

- **TEACHES A CORE SUBJECT OR RELATED TO YOUR MAJOR**

- **IS A CERTAIN SUBJECT REQUIRED?**

- **NEED 2-3 LETTERS? ASK DIFFERENT TEACHERS WHO CAN HIGHLIGHT SEPARATE STRENGTHS.**

- **GIVE THE SCHOOLS WHAT THEY'RE ASKING FOR & STICK TO THEIR LIMITS.**

- **YOUR SCHOOL COUNSELOR WILL ALSO NEED TO WRITE YOU A LETTER.**

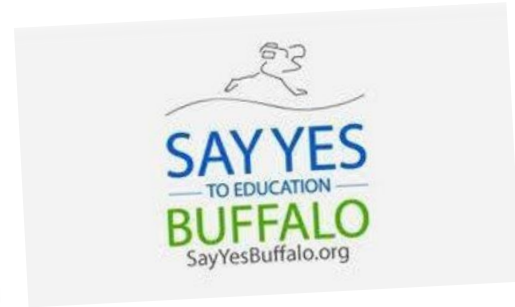
LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION CONT.

- **WHEN?**

- **ASK IN ADVANCE (AT LEAST 2-3 WEEKS BEFORE DUE DATE, END OF JUNIOR YEAR PREFERRED)**
- **IF POSSIBLE, SCHEDULE A MEETING TO ASK.**
- **BE SURE TO FOLLOW UP WITH A THANK YOU EMAIL.**
- **PROVIDE THE PERSON YOU ASK WITH YOUR ACADEMIC/ACTIVITIES RESUME, BRAG SHEET, OR LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION QUESTIONNAIRE (EXAMPLES CAN BE FOUND IN THE CLASS OF 2022 SCHOOLOGY GROUP RESOURCES OR THE CHS SCHOOL COUNSELING WEB PAGE)**

Operated by College Board, there is a fee to apply unless you qualify for SAT fee waivers.

\$25 for one school, \$16 for each additional school



Looks at financial information of the student and their parents



Private colleges and universities use this to determine eligibility for institutional scholarships and grants.

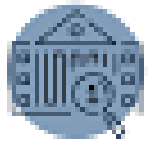

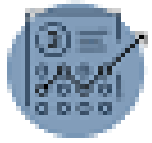

- **BEGIN COMPLETING COLLEGE APPLICATIONS EITHER DIRECTLY THROUGH COLLEGE WEBSITE, SUNY APP, OR THE COMMON APP.**
 - **PLAN TO HAVE THEM COMPLETED BEFORE LEAVING FOR CHRISTMAS BREAK.**
- **CREATE FSA ID. START FAFSA & TAP.**
- **COMPLETE THE SAY YES APPLICATION.**
