PURPOSE

- To recognize LGBTQIA+ and straight ally students in Western New York
- To encourage continuing education, activism, and support for LGBTQIA+ persons and community
- To foster a positive image of LGBTQIA+ young people

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicant must be a graduating senior from a WNY high school.
- Applicant must be a self-identified LGBTQIA+ student or a straight ally.
- Applicant must have been accepted to an accredited post-secondary educational institution or career-training program approved by voting committee.

TERMS

- Two scholarships are \$500.00 each. This year, the Elizabeth "Babs" Conant Memorial Scholarship will be \$600.00. The scholarship committee will decide which of the three recipients will receive the \$600.00 scholarship.
- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the institutions of the recipients.
- The award must be used within one year of graduation.
- Application information will be kept confidential unless permission has been otherwise given.
- Application must be received BEFORE May 1st at PFLAG Buffalo/Niagara's P.O. box.
- Applications must include personal information form, essay, and reference.
- Winners of the awards will be notified before or at graduation.

CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION

- Affirmation of LGBTQIA+ identity or straight ally support
- Participation in events and activities supporting the LGBTQIA+ community
- Specific details of past and/or current commitment to LGBTQ+ and specific details of future support
- Demonstration of integrity and honesty
- Determination to achieve personal and academic goals
- Supporting references which reference and reinforce LGBTQIA+ support are optimal
- Grammar, spelling, structure, and neatness of application will be considered.
