CHS Grade 12 Families:

Based on recent fundraising by the senior class, and final quotes from vendors, **senior dues have been set at \$210** and are due by April 12. Senior dues cover a wide range of expenses associated with senior year. By using a dues system, our senior class leadership seeks to avoid families having to make multiple payments throughout the year and we reduce costs for seniors by ordering in bulk. The cost of senior dues includes, but is not limited to:

-One (1) yearbook for each senior.

-Professionally printed graduation announcements for each senior, to share with family and friends.

-Keepsake graduation programs that are professionally formatted and printed.

-Cap, gown, and stole to wear at the graduation ceremony.

-One (1) ticket to the Senior Dinner at Riverworks on May 21<sup>st</sup> (families may purchase additional depending on which family members they would like present).

-Rental of Kleinhans Music Hall and stage flowers. Rental costs include Kleinhans staff and security. The City Honors Foundation provides a substantial subsidy to the senior class to help cover the cost of Kleinhans. Use of Kleinhans allows families may bring unlimited guests to graduation and to enjoy the ceremony in a beautiful and airconditioned environment, with excellent acoustics.

-Special CHS diploma cover.

-Professionally printed diplomas.

-CHS Class of 2024 hoodie.

-Class of 2024 gift to the school community.

Check or money order will be accepted (made payable to "City Honors School") for \$210.00 or through the new School Cash App. Once you register for SchoolCash using the instructions <u>at this link</u>, you will see the senior dues option in your account. We prefer that families avoid paying in cash, as we do not want students transporting large sums of money. However, our school finance clerk can accept cash if absolutely necessary. Families that have a credit from the Camp Pathfinder trip that was cancelled in eighth grade will receive a separate letter from our school finance clerk, Ms. Rodriguez, explaining how to redeem this credit.

At the start of the school year, all seniors were provided with a list of important dates related to senior year. For your convenience, these dates are included on page 2 of this document.
