## Dear Parent or Guardian:

The Buffalo Public Schools' Department of Multilingual Education is about to launch an exciting initiative that will enhance the learning experience of its students this year and for years to come. We have been selected by the New York State Education Department to participate in a New York State Seal of Biliteracy Implementation and Design Pilot Program for the 2014 - 2015 school year. The State Seal of Biliteracy was passed by the legislature and signed into law by Governor Cuomo on July 31, 2012. It was established to recognize high school graduates who have attained a high level of proficiency in listening, speaking, reading and writing in English and one or more languages.

We see this as a prime opportunity to capitalize on the rich diversity in our district and highlight the achievements of our multilingual student population. In addition, as members of a global community it is a way of motivating our English speaking students to learn another language. Through bilingualism and biliteracy, all our students will be better prepared to meet the challenges of the Common Core and be better prepared for college, career, and their future. The following schools will participate in the pilot this year: City Honors School, Frederick Law Olmsted School at Kensington, Hutchinson Central Technical High School and Lafayette High School.
