CHS Class of 2022 Families:

The Herrmann Studio will be doing senior portraits at CHS on June 10th and 11th in the LGI room.

In order to have your photo taken, [you must sign up for a photo appointment using this link](#).

Please select the time slot that you prefer and book your appointment. Times are 8:30 am to 2:30 pm. **Please note that you need to arrive at least 5 minutes prior to your scheduled time to ensure that we are able to stay on schedule each day.**

Guidelines for Portrait Sessions:

If a student is learning remotely on their selected date, they must enter the building using the main entrance on Fosdick Street. Upon arrival, students must complete a health screening form and have their temperature taken. If a student is already present for in-person learning, they will already have had their temperature taken and completed the health screening form that morning. While we know that this schedule is more convenient for those attending in-person learning on Thursday/Fridays, please understand that these dates were the only available dates from the studio. If we could have, we would have accommodated our Monday/Tuesday in-person learners. All students must wear a mask and adhere to CDC social distancing guidelines.

City Honors School and Herrmann Studio will follow CDC guidelines to ensure the safety and well-being of all families. Photographers will be wearing a mask at all times, in addition to having hand sanitizer and wipes available for use after each student appointment. The camera will be positioned 6 feet from the student being photographed.

In past years, a tuxedo jacket and drape options were available to students. However, this year, we are not permitted to use photo props since there is no way to sanitize them properly between student use. The recommended dress attire includes solid colors, a long sleeve button down shirt and tie (suit jacket optional) for boys, and a dress shirt, sweater or simple neckline shirt for girls.

All students must adhere to the BPS Dress Code and note that a person's dress, grooming and appearance must:

- not promote and/or endorse the use of alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs and/or encourage other illegal or violent activities
- not be lewd, vulgar, obscene, and libelous or denigrate others
- not include revealing garments such as tube tops, net tops, halter tops, spaghetti straps, plunging necklines (front and/or back) see-through garments.
