1. The 5th & 6th grade dance is a PTSCO-sponsored event; in no way is City Honors School FMP or Buffalo Public Schools responsible for this event. PTSCO will consistently enforce the CHS Middle School Code of Conduct and dress code.
2. Any inappropriate conduct could result in losing the privilege of attending dances throughout the year. Fighting or bullying of any kind will not be tolerated. All students involved in such behavior will be expected to call for a ride and be picked up immediately.
3. The dance is open to 5th & 6th grade CHS students only. **PTSCO and its volunteers will only allow entry with a permission slip and payment for admission.**
4. Once admitted, students must have a parent or guardian escort them to leave the dance.
5. Parents have volunteered their time to help keep the dance running smoothly and to enforce all guidelines. All chaperones have the authority to dismiss any students who do not comply with the guidelines from the dance.
