In-Person Testing Information



- All students should report at the listed time for their exam below.
- Students who are not already at school for in-person classes must enter through the main entrance on Fosdick Street.
- Students coming in from outside will walk through the main entrance thermal scanner, then make their way to their locker where they will place their phone in their locker. Students already in school should report to their lockers at their assigned report time.
- School personnel will secure phones for all students who are not a part of hybrid learning and have not been assigned a locker. Phones may be claimed right after students exit the exams.
- All students should bring two #2 pencils. Pencils will be provided to those who do not have them.
- After they secure their phones, students will report to the center section of the auditorium seated every other row, three seats in between. Students will be called up to their testing classrooms from the auditorium in small groups to ensure distancing.
- Students will remain in classrooms until testing is complete. Morning exams generally conclude at 12:30pm and afternoon exams at 3:30pm.
- Students already in the building prior to 11:30 exams may take an early lunch prior to the exam. Students who complete an early exam and have classes in the building for the afternoon will be able to pick-up a lunch and take it to their next class.
- Students who are remote for the day, do not need to attend in-person classes before or after the exam.
- **Students who are testing remotely** should refer to the information sent home to their families or contact Mrs. Allman (cmallman@buffaloschools.org) for questions.
- **Students taking AP exams not connected to CHS courses** should contact Mrs. Allman for their report times. (cmallman@buffaloschools.org)
- **We encourage students to get a good night's rest and full breakfast prior to the exam. Use all time available to double and triple check work to be sure it reflects your best effort.**
