

CHS SKI CLUB

Thinking about joining Ski Club? Here is everything you need to know! Ski Club is a parent run program for high school students. It's a great way to spend some time with your friends on a Friday night. Everything you need to know should be answered right here. If you have any other questions the ski club contact information is included below.

HOW DO I JOIN?

There are two things you have to do to join ski club. The first is to complete the registration form and send it with a \$150 check. The second is to go online using our exclusive link and purchase a ski pass from Holiday Valley.

WHAT ARE THE DATES?

Ski club is every Friday with the exceptions of President's week. The dates for 2020 are January 3, 10, 17, 24, 31; February 7, 14, 28

WHERE DO I GET THE BUS AND WHAT TIME DOES IT LEAVE?

The bus leaves from the Kohl's parking lot in North Buffalo, and then makes a stop at the Home Depot on Ridge Road in South Buffalo. The bus leaves Kohl's at 3:30 and we plan to leave The Home Depot by 4:00

WHAT TIME DO WE GET HOME?

We will leave Holiday Valley no later than 10:00. You should plan on being picked up at 11:15 at the Kohl's parking lot; about 11 at The Home Depot.

WHAT IF I'VE NEVER SKIED?

Six lessons come with every pass purchased, no matter your ability. Many students ski for the first time with the ski club. Let us know you are a first time skier, and one of the chaperones will help you get all of your gear and show you to your lesson.

WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE EQUIPMENT?

Rentals are available from Holiday Valley. You will need to select the rental option as you purchase your pass (DON'T FORGET THE HELMET). The rentals are for the entire season.

WHAT KIND OF SKI PASS DO I GET?

When you log on you will see that you can purchase any type of pass at our discounted rate. Most kids get the Friday Night Ultimate Select. This pass is good all season long for ANY Friday night, even on Friday's there isn't a CHS bus. You also get an additional day in March and six hour long lessons.

CAN MY FAMILY AND FRIENDS ALSO BUY PASSES?

YES! Anyone is eligible for the discounted passes. Simply log on using the information below. Once you are on the ecommerce site you may purchase any of the passes shown. The more passes that are sold, the better it is for the club.

WHEN DO I HAVE TO DECIDE BY?

Holiday valley raises all of the pass prices by \$10 on November 1st. You may continue to buy passes after that date, they will just cost \$10 more. The application for CHS ski club needs to be in by **Thanksgiving**.

WHY IS THERE AN EXTRA COST IN ADDITION TO THE SKI PASS?

The extra cost is to run the CHS ski club. It funds the 8 bus trips, snacks and water at the end of each night, and the big end of season party held on the last night at HV.

HOW DO I BUY PASSES FROM HOLIDAY VALLEY?

Print out the form: below, and send it (or drop it off) to the address below. Be sure to fill out ALL of the information and include a \$150 check payable to PTSCO.

Send completed form and a check made out to PTSCO for \$150 by 10/31 to secure your spot on the bus. Bus seats are on a first come first serve basis. Should the first bus fill up, we will only order a second bus if there is enough people. If you should miss out on the first bus you should still send in your completed information with payment to increase the numbers toward a second bus.

STUDENTS MAY BE EXCLUDED FROM SKI & SNOWBOARD CLUB FOR ONE (1) CALENDAR YEAR FROM THE DATE OF THE INFRACTION, WHICH COULD RESULT IN EXCLUSION FOR THE SUBSEQUENT SCHOOL YEAR.
