Thinking about joining Ski Club? Here is everything you need to know! Ski Club is a parent run program for high school students. It's a great way to spend some time with your friends on a Friday night. Everything you need to know should be answered right here. If you have any other questions the ski club contact information is included below.

HOW DO I JOIN? WHAT DOES THE BUS COST?

There are two things you have to do to join ski club:

1. The first thing is to complete the bus registration form and mail it with a check to secure your space on the bus.

2. Second, go online using our exclusive link and purchase a ski pass from Holiday Valley. Passes are discounted until **10/31/22**

HOW DO I SIGN UP FOR THE BUS?

Print out the forms that follow and mail it (or drop it off) to the address shown. Be sure to fill out ALL of the information and include a check payable to PTSCO.

HOW DO I BUY PASSES FROM HOLIDAY VALLEY?

On the following page is a link to take you to the e-commerce site. Sign in with the username and password. Once there, you may select any type of pass, rental and helmet as needed. [Click the menu for more pass options.](#)

WHAT ARE THE DATES?

Ski club skis every Friday, with the exception of President's week.

The dates for 2023 are January 6, 13, 20, 27; February 3, 10, 17; March 3.

DO I NEED TO RIDE THE BUS?

No. You are welcome to purchase ski passes and ski on your own.

WHERE DO I GET THE BUS AND WHAT TIME DOES IT LEAVE?

The bus leaves from the Kohl's parking lot in North Buffalo, and then makes a stop at the Home Depot on Ridge Road in South Buffalo. The bus leaves Kohl's at 3:30 and we plan to leave The Home Depot by 4:00

WHAT TIME DO WE GET HOME?

We will leave Holiday Valley promptly at 10:00. You should plan on being picked up at 10:45 at The Home Depot and 11:00 at Kohl's.

WHAT IF I'VE NEVER SKIED?

Six lessons come with every pass purchased, no matter your ability. Many students ski for the first time with the ski club. Let us know you are a first time skier, and one of the chaperones will help you get all of your gear and show you to your lesson.

WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE EQUIPMENT?

Rentals are available from Holiday Valley. You will need to select the rental option as you purchase your pass (DON'T FORGET THE HELMET). The rentals are for the entire season.

WHAT KIND OF SKI PASS SHOULD I BUY?

When you log on you will see that you can purchase any type of pass at our discounted rate. Most students buy the Friday Night Ultimate Select. This pass is good all season long for ANY Friday night. Even on Fridays there isn't a CHS bus. You also get a bonus any day pass in March and six, hour long lessons.

CAN MY FAMILY AND FRIENDS ALSO BUY DISCOUNTED PASSES?

YES! Anyone is eligible for the discounted passes. Simply log in using the information below. Once you are on the e-commerce site you may purchase any of the passes shown. The more passes that are sold, the better it is for the club.

On the web page be sure to click the menu in the upper lefthand corner for more pass options, including student and college season passes.

WHEN DO I HAVE TO DECIDE BY?

Holiday valley raises all of the pass prices on November 1st. You may continue to buy passes after that date, they will just cost more. The application for CHS ski club needs to be in by **Thanksgiving** at the latest.

WHY IS THERE AN EXTRA COST IN ADDITION TO THE SKI PASS?

The extra cost is to run the CHS ski club. It funds the 8 bus trips, driver gratuity, an end of the season party, etc. The parties are only open to students riding the bus.

ANY INFRACTION OF THE RULES WILL RESULT IN LOSS OF SKI & SNOWBOARD CLUB PRIVILEGES FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE SCHOOL YEAR, AS WELL AS OTHER CONSEQUENCES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, EXCLUSION FROM FURTHER PARTICIPATION AND FORFEITURE OF ALL FEES PAID FOR LIFT TICKETS, BUS TRANSPORTATION AND EQUIPMENT RENTALS. STUDENTS MAY BE EXCLUDED FROM SKI & SNOWBOARD CLUB FOR ONE (1) CALENDAR YEAR FROM THE DATE OF THE INFRACTION, WHICH COULD RESULT IN EXCLUSION FOR THE SUBSEQUENT SCHOOL YEAR.
