## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR SENIOR YEAR CLASS OF 2020

★ Senior Dues—for the Class of 2020 they are \$280. Dues cover: student yearbook, hoodie, senior dinner attendance, class gift, rental of Kleinhans, flowers at Kleinhans, graduation announcements, graduation program, cap, gown, tassel, and diploma covers. **Dues should be paid by December 6, 2019.** Dues can be in installments in the form(s) of cash, check, or money order and turned in to Mr. Howson. ## SLI at a Glance

City Honors School recognizes the importance of engaging students with learning throughout their experience at the school, including the final months of their senior year. Both the International Baccalaureate Program and the faculty of the school put a strong emphasis on service to one's community. With these principles in mind, CHS offers senior year students an additional opportunity for both service and learning through out-of-school experiences following the culmination of IB and AP examinations. Students in strong academic and citizenship standing will be offered an opportunity to participate in this program.

- The Student Learning Initiative (SLI) runs from May 18 to June 16, 2020.
- Students are expected to participate every school day, for a minimum of four hours a day during the hours of 8 am and 4 pm. Students who are not enrolled in the Service Learning Initiative are expected to attend all classes until the conclusion of the school year.
- Each student must submit an SLI application to Mr. Howson, including all teacher signatures
  and an explanation of the placement they found OR a description of the kind of placement they
  hope to find.
- We strongly encourage students to find their own placements with organizations that meet the requirements of the SLI program. This is the only way a student can really guarantee a placement he/she knows they would like. There are several organizations with which CHS has a long-standing relationships. Students may not intern with family members.
- A teacher has every right to NOT SIGN OFF on your paperwork if you are not in good standing in their class. In some cases, depending on the schedule, students may be able to attend that class AND participate in SLI. A student may be pulled from SLI for failure to comply with the expectations or requirements of a given teacher even if they initially signed the application.
- Students MAY NOT use a part-time job or supplement other paid employment for the Senior Service Learning Initiative at City Honors School. The SLI program is voluntary and unpaid. Students are not allowed to accept payment or other compensation.
- You must complete 20 days of SLI in total, after which students must submit time logs and reflection sheets. Daily attendance credit will be received for attending the SLI Experience.
- If you have an AP/IB exam AFTER **May 18**, you MUST attend the class for that exam until the exam is given unless the teacher for that course provides alternate allowances.
- NFTA "passes" will be available to those who request them on their SLI paperwork. They will be distributed in May, before SLI begins.
