2024 Scholarship Program Guidelines

- 1) The Erie County (NY) Chapter of the Links Incorporated scholarships are available to; students of African descent, full-time first year students entering college or university (two or four year) in 2024 after graduating from high school in 2024.
- 2) The deadline for the application to be received is <u>Saturday</u>, <u>March 30, 2024</u>. (NO EXCEPTIONS)
- 3) Refer to the application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed. (i.e., reference forms, evidence of GPA, and so forth). Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 4) If any question does not apply to you, please put N/A in the space provided.
- 5) Type or legibly print all information. Illegible applications will be returned to you.
- 6) You will be notified by May 31, 2024 of your award.

PURPOSE: The Erie County (NY) Chapter of The Links awards scholarship money to deserving students. The mission of the scholarship program is to provide financial assistance to individuals who are enrolled in a college/university undergraduate studies program. It is only available to first year undergraduate students.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: Assistance is based on financial need, academic performance, leadership potential, and participation in community programs, including but not limited to volunteer hours.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA: The Erie County (NY) Chapter of The Links awards scholarships on the basis of a comprehensive selection process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to; academic accomplishments, community service, references, personal essay and financial need. The Erie County (NY) Chapter of The Links scholarships are awarded to those students of African descent. The student will be graduating from high school in 2024 and planning to attend as a first-year student in a college or university (two or four-year) in 2024.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD: The Erie County (NY) Chapter of The Links will notify the student if selected for a scholarship award in the Spring of 2024. Scholarship funds will be distributed after the student provides confirmation of attendance in college in 2024.
