# Alumni Scholarship

The CHS Alumni Scholarship has been presented each year since 2005, thanks to the anonymous generosity of a loyal City Honors alum who seeks to give back what they were given at their moment of need as a young person.

Graduating seniors from City Honors School who meet the following criteria are encouraged to apply:

1. A demonstrated commitment to their studies
2. Financially disadvantaged background with significant financial need to fund their education
3. Have been admitted, and plan to attend, a well-respected college outside of the Buffalo area

Scholarships are typically \$2,000 per year, for each of four years of undergraduate education. The number of recipients and award amount provided to each recipient may vary each year. Checks are issued to students prior to the start of each year of their undergraduate education. Funds may be directed toward tuition, room, board, travel or other expenses related to completing a student's undergraduate education.

The CHS Alumni Scholarship is administered through the City Honors/Fosdick-Masten Park Foundation. Recipients must meet the following conditions to continue to receive a scholarship check during years 2-4 of their undergraduate education:

1. Remain in contact with the Foundation's designee for the scholarship (Mrs. Banas).
2. Provide an updated annual copy of their college's financial award letter.
3. Submit documentation to verify they remain in good academic standing at their college.

The only consideration that the benefactor of this scholarship asks in return is that, someday, when recipients have arrived at success in their own careers and some measure of financial stability, they consider giving back to other young City Honors Centaurs in need.
