### **Student Safety Alert**

If you are picking-up or dropping-off your child at City Honors, it is critical that you expect congestion and demonstrate patience. Important reminders for parents transporting their children: -Do not stop your car in the middle of the street. Only stop your car on Fosdick Street if you find a school-side curb to pull along so your child can enter/exit the vehicle right onto the curb.

-Do not enter the school parking lot prior to 4:00pm.

-Do not pick-up/drop-off on North Street or Masten Avenue. These are not safe areas for student pick-up/drop-off due to bus transport and staff entering the main parking lot.

-Reduce your stress: drop your child to school early or pick them up ten minutes after dismissal to avoid peak traffic.

-Please do not attempt to retrieve your child from the school between 2:45 and 3:09 unless it is an emergency as our administrative and office staff is focused at this time on preparing students for an orderly dismissal.

The Buffalo Public Schools and Superintendent Dr. Tonja Williams are committed to the restoration of Fosdick Field and the elimination of Fosdick Street which causes traffic congestion around our school and reduces walk-ability/bike-ability for our students. We ask for your patience until we are able to arrive at this reconfiguration of traffic patterns.

#### Security Screening and Transportation

CHS Families- Thank you for your patience and support as our school district has been implementing new systems this school year for yellow bus transportation and screening students upon arrival. Dr. Kresse is communicating areas in need of improvement to the district. We will continue to work on

solutions and advocate for improvements until all systems work properly for our students.
