Mr. Mueckl Day: School Closed April 8 Due to Solar Eclipse!

Dear BPS Community: This letter is meant to inform you that Buffalo Public Schools will be closed on Monday, April 8, 2024, due to a historic solar eclipse expected in the Western New York Region. The eclipse is predicted to coincide with student dismissal and increased tourism which may impact traffic and roadways. Please be aware that all other school districts in the Western New York Region will also be closed on this date. In the event additional instructional time is required, the district may convert June 26, 2024, and/or June 27, 2024, into instructional days to meet New York State's minimum standards. 
