Additional PSAT Prep Date Scheduled

All seats for the Courier College Prep in-person PSAT workshop scheduled for September 30th at CHS have been filled. However, **Courier College Prep is opening up a second session on Tuesday October 5** (a minimum of 10 students is required to hold this session). Register for the October 5th workshop at this link.

This workshop will help prepare students who will sit for the PSAT on October 13th. The class will be taught by Brian Eldridge, a leading SAT/ACT tutor, certified college counselor and founder of Courier College Prep. This session will run a little over two hours. The cost is \$20 per student. The City Honors Foundation will cover fees for students who have documented financial fees. Students are encouraged to register early as seats and fee waivers are limited. This workshop will be held in the Large Group Instruction Room (LGI) at CHS.

College Admissions Officer Visits to CHS

Did you know know that an average of 3 to 4 colleges visit CHS each day to provide information and meet with CHS students interested in applying to their school? The roster of college visits is posted for students in advance to Schoology by the school counseling office and a reminder of the visits for the day is read each morning on the morning announcements. Students can attend these sessions by obtaining a pass in the school counseling office. The district has asked that all visits from college admission officers not previosuly scheduled be conducted remotely as they were last school year. Students will continue to see these remote visits publicized and will report to the school counseling office to participate via an interactive board.

Student Vehicles

We would not trade our spectacular building for 1 million other buildings, but if it has a minor shortcoming, it is a lack of expansive parking. COVID Testing

30% of staff and students at CHS will continue to be randomly tested for COVID each week pursuant to current district procedures. This year, CHS will conduct the more accurate and less invasive 24-hour turnaround mandatory Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) testing for COVID-19. **We encourage all staff and students to participate in testing in order to reduce the number of times individuals will need to be tested.** Families are asked to <u>use this link</u> to provide consent to include their child in the pool of students to be tested.

Daily COVID-19 Health Screener

Families should complete the daily health screener once again each day BEFORE their child leaves for

school. <u>This link will take you to this year's screener</u>. Families are encouraged to paste the link into the 'reminder' app on their smart phone to alert you each morning.
