Parent and Student MILITARY RECRUITMENT OPT-OUT FORM For Non-Disclosure of Personal Information

Local Educational Agencies (LEA's) receiving funding assistance under the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, must "comply with requests by military recruiters, to release the names, addresses, and telephone numbers of secondary grade students, *unless* a parent or student has requested in writing to opt-out of providing such information".

The school is required to notify students of their right to opt-out and to further inform them and/or their parents or guardian, that they may submit a written request to withhold such information from the Armed Forces, Military Recruiters, Military Schools, and the U.S. Department of Defense.

Parents or Guardians: If you do not want to have your child's information released to the Armed Forces, Military Recruiters, Military Schools or the U.S. Department of Defense, please complete and return this form to your child's school counselor by September 30th to ensure that the form is received before the District is required to release the student

information to them.

Please use a separate form for each child.

I am aware that the district must provide student names, addresses and telephone numbers to military recruiters when requested. I am also aware that the district will provide this information upon request, unless I request in writing that such information be

withheld from the Armed Forces, Military Recruiters, Military Schools or the U.S. Department of Defense.

DO NOT release my secondary student's information to the Armed Forces, Military Recruiters, Military Schools or the U.S. Department of Defense at any time.
