## Schedule for the Day:

8:12: Seniors who are scheduled for in-person report to homeroom.

9:45: All seniors report to Fosdick Field and sign-in (students will not be admitted after 10:15).

9:45: Seniors can pay any outstanding debts, hand in texts and computers and other equipment at this time.

**9:45:** Seniors with all debts resolved, materials returned and dues paid will be handed their yearbooks as they sign in and will have time to sign each other's yearbooks.

**10:45:** Graduation mini-rehearsal and review of procedures.

11:30: Mr. Howson distributes "letter to self" that students completed in 8<sup>th</sup> grade ELA.

**12:30-2:00:** Lunch- The City Honors Foundation is providing each senior with a \$10 ticket to buy lunch and treats from Cheesy Chick and Yummmm food trucks, possibly one more. Seniors can also bring their own lunch or bring additional money to spend at the trucks. (The only rule: please no sharing of food to avoid any possibility of infection!)

1:30: Senior class awards and induction into the CHS Alumni Association

2:30: Distribution of caps, gowns, stoles, masks, tickets and Covid forms for use at the graduation ceremony at All-High.

## What Can We Do Between Scheduled Events?

Toss a frisbee, play badminton or cornhole, sign yearbooks, sit on a blanket and enjoy each other's company (while social distancing). The Senior Senate is also planning t-shirt decorating and a class photo. Mr. Howson will communicate more about these activities to seniors.

## Really, Really Important Information I Should Know About This Event

-Under new district guidelines, masks are optional outside the school building.

-June 21 is a regular day of attendance and this is a school event so students will be governed by the BPS Code of Conduct. Any conduct issues may impact a student's opportunity to participate in graduation exercises.

-Once seniors sign in for the day, they must stay until 2:45 or until a parent signs them out (yes, this is district procedure).

-Again, please no sharing of food to reduce possibility of spread. We know CHS students are generous, but please hold off on that instinct in this one instance!

## What If Senior Day Is Rained Out?

-We will text families if all or part of the day is rained out. Alternate arrangements will be made for students to pick up their graduation costumes and awards at the building that day. Given that graduation is the next day, we will not have an opportunity to reschedule this event (pray for sunny skies!).
