

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR SENIOR YEAR CLASS OF 2018

- ★ Senior Dues—for the Class of 2018 they are \$275. Dues cover: student yearbook, hoodie, senior dinner attendance, Class gift, rental of Kleinhans, flowers at Kleinhans, graduation announcements, graduation program, cap, gown, tassel, and diploma covers. **Dues are due November 13, 2017** and students will be unable to participate in aforesaid events if failing to pay this fee. Dues can be in installments in the form(s) of cash, check, or money order and turned in to Mr. Howson.
