Supplies you will need for the upcoming school year:

Math: 1 green plastic folder (w/ pocket & prongs), 1 graph composition notebook, 1 scientific calculator (TI30XIIS recommended), 1 ruler (metric and English system), pencils with erasers, loose-leaf graph paper, large glue sticks.

ELA: 1-1 ¹/₂" binder, 1 pack of dividers with tabs, 1 pack dry erase markers with an eraser or rag, 2"x1¹/₂" postit notes, 1 red plastic folder (w/ pocket and prongs)

Science/Social Studies 1-1 inch binder, black and blue pens, 1 pack of dividers with pockets and tabs

Entering Grade 7

Supplies you will need for the upcoming school year:

Math: Pencils, 1 graph paper composition notebook (with grid lines) and a Scientific calculator TI30XIIS (strongly recommended)

ELA: 1 inch binder, 1 pack of 5 dividers, loose-leaf paper (college-ruled), pens (blue or black ink only) Pencils (#2), erasers, highlighters, a USB drive (aka *jump, stick, flash, or thumb* 4 GB drive). Your child's name should be the name in the device. If you need help with this, I will teach you how to change it.

Social Studies: 2 inch binder, pens, #2 pencils and loose-leaf paper
