Supplies you will need for the upcoming school year:

General: 2 packages of loose-leaf paper, pencils, pencil pouch, erasers

Math: 1 two-pocket folder

ELA: 1 composition notebook, 1 two-pocket folder

Science and Social Studies: 1 two-pocket folder (shared by Science & Social Studies)

World Language: 1 3 ring binder 2 inch, 1 box of colored pencils, 1 box of crayons, scissors. (Shared by Spanish/Mandarin, French/Mandarin)

Art/Music: A sketchbook (hardbound 8 1/2x11) to be used in both 5th and 6th grade, colored pencils (no erasable colored pencils), eraser and regular pencils, sharpie pen or Sharpie ultra-fine tip marker, any additional art materials they want to use at home. Music: Pencils, composition notebook, Dry-erase marker.

Gym: Rubber soled sneakers with laces or fastened tightly to the feet, change of clothes, for example t-shirt, sweatshirt, shorts, or sweatpants.

Supplies you will need for the upcoming school year:

Math: 1 green plastic folder (w/ pocket & prongs), 1 graph composition notebook, 1 scientific calculator (TI30XIIS recommended & is the same calculator as provided for state testing), loose-leaf graph paper.

ELA: 1-1 ½" binder (*Please try to find plastic rings! This will be a great help to staff and your student when coming through the metal detectors in the morning!*), 1 pack of dividers with tabs, 2"x1½" post-it notes, 1 package of college ruled lined paper, highlighters (pink, yellow and green).

Science/Social Studies 1 yellow plastic folder (with pockets and prongs), 1 purple plastic folder (with pockets and prongs).

World Language: 1 3 ring binder 2 inch, 1 box of colored pencils, 1 box of crayons, scissors. (Shared by Spanish/Mandarin, French/Mandarin)

Art: A sketchbook (hardbound $8\ 1/2x11$) to be used in both 5th and 6th grade, colored pencils (no erasable colored pencils), eraser and regular pencils, sharpie pen or Sharpie ultra-fine tip marker, any additional art materials they want to use at home.

Entering Grade 7

Supplies you will need for the upcoming school year:

Math: Pencils, 1 graph paper composition notebook (with grid lines) and a Scientific calculator TI30XIIS (strongly recommended)

ELA: A functioning BPS issued laptop, 1 inch binder, 1 pocket folder (any color), 1 pack of 5 dividers, loose-leaf paper (college-ruled), pens (blue or black ink only) Pencils (#2), erasers, highlighters, a USB drive (aka jump, stick, flash, or thumb 4 GB drive). Your child's name should be the name in the device. If you need help with this, I will teach you how to change it.

Social Studies: A functioning BPS issued laptop. Pens, pencils and loose-leaf paper. No binders.

Science: 1 folder with pockets, 2 spiral bound notebooks (100 pages each), pencils, pens, highlighters, a scientific calculator (TI30XIIS) is recommended but not required. Suggested: 1 box of Kleenex for your homeroom teacher.

Art: A sketchbook (hardbound 8-1/2x11), colored pencils (no erasable colored pencils), eraser and regular pencils, sharpie pen or Sharpie ultra-fine tip marker, any additional art materials they want to use at home.

World Language (one):
